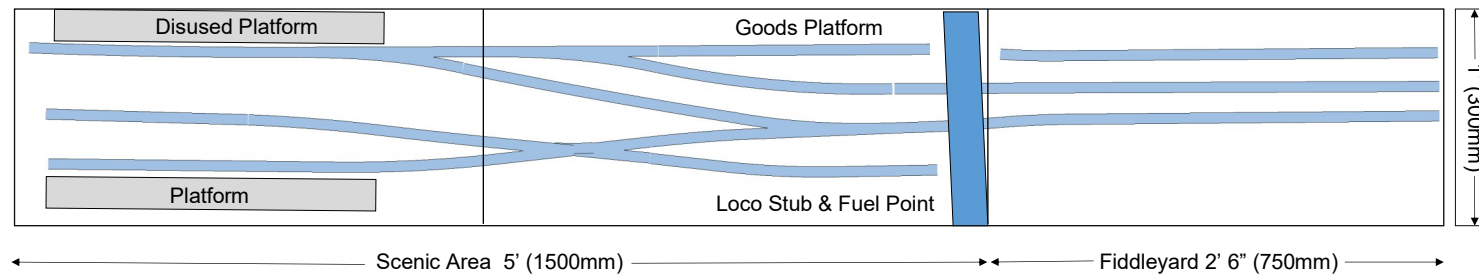
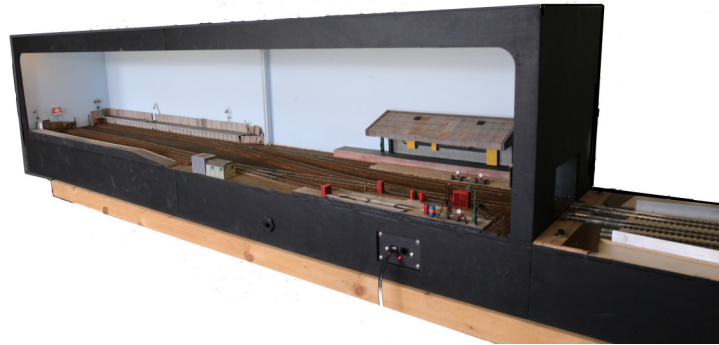




# Elbow Lane



Elbow Lane is a small yard with a short semi-dilapidated platform for shuttle trains. Another old platform is no longer used for passengers and is a shunting neck for the Goods shed/platform. There is also a small Loco stub that also doubles as a fuelling point. Some would call it a Micro Layout at a total of 7' 6" or 2250mm. It uses DCC Sound to full effect in its loco stud but with pointwork operated by a Servos. Trackwork is the new Peco 00 Bullhead and rolling stock uses hands-free magnetic couplings. The layout is usually operated from the front at the fiddleyard end and has its own internal lighting by LEDs.

The layout's home is in West Sussex close to Gatwick and is available for one or two day shows. For one day shows I would hope to be less than 70miles away. For two day shows that are over 60 miles away I would need accommodation. The layout travels in my personal car so the only costs would be fuel. I would need **one large table** and a power supply with at least **one socket**. Power consumption is up to about **7amps**. I also use an RCD.
