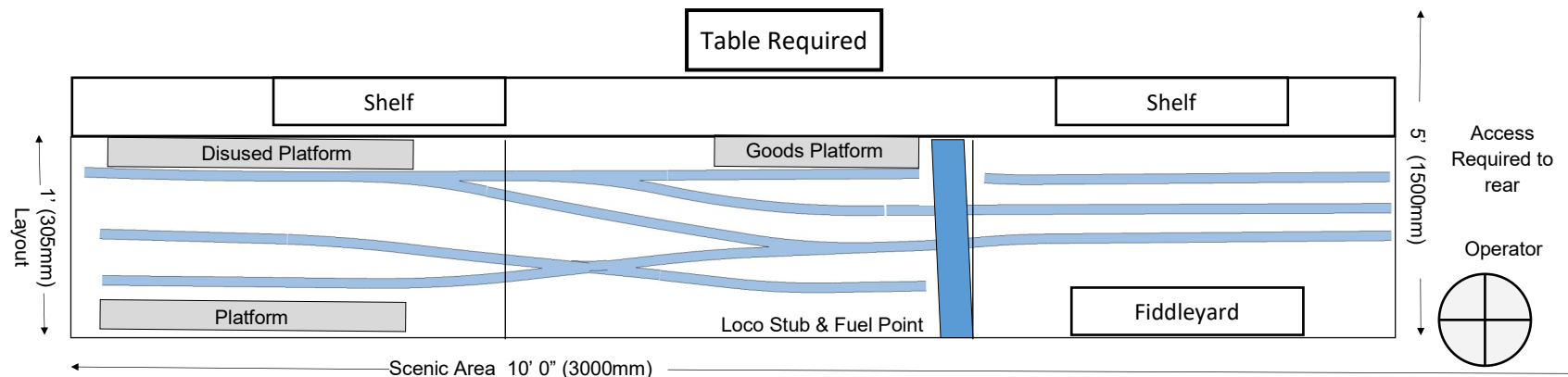
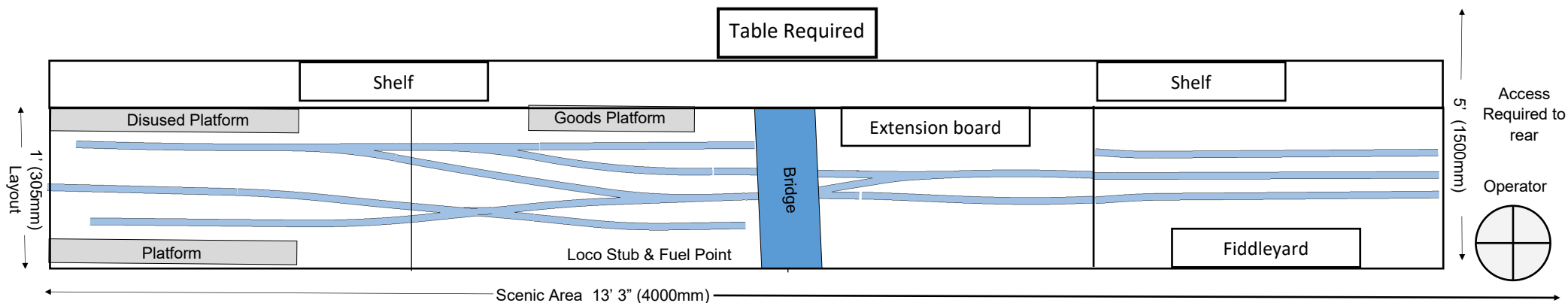


Elbow Lane 00



ORIGINAL OR EXTENDED



Elbow Lane is a small run down Branch Terminus in South London. It has a short dilapidated platform for passenger trains. Another older platform is no longer used and is now just a shunting neck for the goods dock. A small Loco stub also doubles as a fuelling point. The original layout overall is 7' 6" long incl an open fiddleyard. There is also now an extended version. *See plans and below.* DCC Sound is used to full effect in the loco fleet. Trackwork is 00 Bullhead and rolling stock uses hands-free magnetic couplings. The layout is operated from in front of the fiddleyard and has its own intergral lighting using LEDs. **Note:** Track level is 1200mm above floor so should be considered as a High Level Layout for viewers.

Short footprint is 9' (3000mm) x 5' (1500mm) deep. Extended footprint is 4000mm x 1500mm. Plus a table at the rear is required.

The layout's home is close to Gatwick Airport and is available for one or two day shows. Contact me about one day shows and the distance needed to travel. For two day shows that are over 60/70 miles away I would prefer to have accommodation. I layout requires the following: **one medium sized table and one power socket with RCD.** It travels in my personal car so the only costs are fuel/accommodation. The layout requires two operators. **Please Note:** I am unable to climb stairs. *Appeared Model Rail Mag 2021*
